NEW BUSINESS

Trailer Changes

On August 14th 3:00 am four individuals cut open the shire trailer located at 31272 Peardonville road. Location known as Savaric's shop. The thieves tried to cut the lock but couldn't. They were able to cut the part that holds the lock, the hasp. Savaric has it on his CC security video. Savaric was able to replace the part for \$10.00. We need to find a new home for the trailer as soon as possible.

The following night the thieves came back, however the trail was safely locked and hidden in Savaric's shop. Savaric watched the CCTV on another monitor and discover that they made multiple trips to their small car from the trailer. At this time as far as we can determine they probably made five trips to their car from the trailer and most likely took the pavilion roof, gate file boxes, and some undetermined totes. *See below for complete list.

That Saturday Porzia and I drove around the area to checked for dumped goods. Nothing was found.

Savaric did a police report and provided them with a copy of the CCTV footage.

I watched some of the video. The thieves knew exactly what they were doing. They were very organized, as well as, checked and attempted to gain access to other trailers in the area. I also want to tell you that one of Savaric's employees was sleeping 50 feet away in his tiny home and didn't hear anything. Each time the thieves came it was 3:00-4:00 am.

I do not feel comfortable storing the trailer at this location any further. We need to find another place. At the moment the trailer is located at the home of Savaric but can not stay there.

The following weekend, August 20th, 2021 a trailer inventory was done by Savaric, Porzia, and Luther. The items are missing are:

1. Kube game set in duffel

- 2. Bow
- 3. Panther pavilion with ropes
- 4. Gate box #6

Trailer Storage and/or New Locks

- Savaric is proposing purchasing new locks to cover the hasps, as well as adding a second hasp to each of the doors
 - 2 new hasps
 - 4 new locks
- Our current storage at Dave's work is no longer suitable
- We are looking into other new storage locations, but paying for a space at U-Haul would cost \$110/month
 - Motioned to approve a \$500 budget for new locks and hasps
 - 7 yay, 1 abstain
 - Motioned to have the trailer stored at Wulfstan and Elspeth's home
 - 6 yay, 2 abstain
 - Motion to approve the purchase of an outdoor camera to be installed at Wulfstan and Elspeth's home to monitor the trailer
 - 5 yay, 4 abstain
 - Hjordis will research some outdoor cameras and give some quotes for next month's camera

 - Pronunciation assistance:
 - Sto:lo = Staw-lo
 - Sts'ailes = Styles
 - Sq'éwlets = Scowlitz
 - Lytton = Lit-un
 - Coast Salish = Coast Say-lish
- This will be followed up on in September, to allow folks to give consideration as to how they would feel about integrating a land acknowledgement in our business meetings
 - And a request was brought up to consider providing same at events. The logistics of this would have to be considered, as to do it properly, and respectfully
