- Over the first three quarters of 2024 the Shire has managed to remain financially stable. The great results from events has offset the early expenses associated with building the participation at the semi-monthly practices. Though I have been informed by Cameron that the September practices broke even. It was anticipated that it would take some time to build the practices to the point where they were self supporting and hopefully September is an indicator that we are getting to that point. Thanks to the great efforts of the practice team and the events teams the Shire is in good financial shape. The bank balance as of the end of September is \$12,603.91.
